### *Reopening Protocols*

---

#### **Screening**

- Students must be escorted into the building by a parent or guardian for their temperature to be taken. If the temperature is 100.4 or higher, and does not return to normal after a reasonable wait time, the parent/guardian must take the child home.
- Immediately send person to a designated isolation area where they will be provided with a mask and gloves and prepare to leave campus as necessary. Report the child's information on the provided form and forward to the parish office. Create a list of all who may have been exposed.
- Be aware of the following symptoms: cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, chills, headache, sore throat, bluish lips or face, fever.

#### **Social Distancing**

- Employees, students, parents are to follow CDC recommended 6 feet distance from others and illuminate contact with others whenever possible.
- Everyone must follow the established taped lines/signage marking the walking directions throughout the campus in order to maintain social distancing requirements.
- All extracurricular events/activities, including informal meetings are to be suspended/avoided until further notice.
- The outside picnic tables may not be used.
- No gathering in groups outside or inside the campus.
- Everyone over the age of two is required to wear a mask.
- Hand sanitizer is to be provided at each designated entrance of a facility and is required to be used by every individual prior to entry. Hand sanitizer

should also be available in every classroom. Students and staff should be directed to use it frequently.

### **Student Related Protocols**

- Supplies (e.g. markers, books) should be designated for use by individual students.
- Groups will consist of age appropriate students.
- Students will remain with their assigned group at all times. Students are not to visit other classrooms.
- Students will be trained on the required social distancing protocols and health practices.
- Students will be mindful of social distancing and health practices or they cannot remain on campus.
- Students will not share spaces, supplies, or work in small groups.
- Students will use restrooms at designated times; the number of students admitted into a restroom at a time will be no more than the number of sinks in the restroom.

### **General Protocols**

- Do not plan any activities that would require people to interact within 6 feet apart.
- Youth on site should not participate in activities that would make it difficult to maintain consistent social distancing or with the likely potential for spreading the virus. There is to be NO singing or dancing.
- Parents/guardians are not to congregate within or outside of the campus, at any time.
